Arrival in Cairo

Our representative will meet you at the airport, greet you with a personalized sign, and assist you to your private air-conditioned vehicle to transfer to your hotel.

Day 2

Cairo tour + Overnight train to Aswan

Your Egyptologist tour guide will take you to two historic locations in Egypt that will deeply impact visitors as they discover the mysteries of the ancient world. The Egyptian Museum stands as one of the earth's top museums because its modern architectural excellence meets timeless Egyptian artifacts. Enter an authentic Egyptian restaurant and try the typical lunch menu. After enjoying your meal, continue your tour at Pyramids of Giza, which survived as the final Ancient World Wonder.

Look up at the Great Pyramid while learning how experts have kept these structures standing since ancient times. Your <u>Egypt tour</u> ends with a visit to the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a monumental limestone statue sculpted as a single rock. You will be transported from Giza to the Giza Railway Station in the evening so that you can catch an overnight train to Aswan.

Day 3

Aswan free day

Spend a free day in Aswan or select optional tours to <u>Philae Temple</u>. Take a boat to Agilkia Island to observe how the Philae temple was relocated there as Lake Nasser's waters rose.

Visitors can study ancient Egyptian worship because Isis Temple stands well preserved with divine carvings and beautiful columns. Have a dinner meal at Nubian Village with a local family who will host you with authentic Nubian warmth.

Day 4

Aswan tour

Enjoy your free day in Aswan with the optional activity of visiting Abu Simbel Temples.

Accommodation: Hotel (1 night)

Meals: breakfast only.

Day 5

Nile Felucca

You will visit the Tomb of the Nobles and choose some food for your journey before boarding your unique ship this morning. Spend your night sleeping under the moonlight on the river. New members of your sailing crew from Nubia will handle food preparation and show you various traditional dances. You will need your own sleeping sheet to make sleeping on deck during the night more comfortable because feluccas do not provide much shelter.

Accommodation: Felucca (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 6

Head to Luxor

Your private car will take you from Nubian crew separation to Luxor, where you can visit Karnak Temple as a destination. This temple stands as the largest religious construction ever built and was dedicated to Amun-Ra. Discover the 134 columns of the Hypostyle Hall and take in the magnificent obelisks, holy water, and intricately carved historical scenes.

The rest of the day is yours to relax at teahouses or explore local stores.

Accommodation: Hotel (1 night)

Meals: breakfast only.

Optional activities:

Explore the stunning Luxor Temple and be astounded by its size, then stop by the Luxor Museum to see a wonderful display of historic artifacts. End your day by touring the Mummification Museum to learn about the complex process of mummification employed by the ancient Egyptians.

Day 7

Luxor - Overnight train

Start your morning by traveling from Luxor into the West Bank area to see ancient Egyptian relics. Explore the Valley of the Kings to see Book of the Dead scenes and ancient writings in royal tombs of Tutankhamun Ramses II and Seti I. For 3400 years, these Colossi of Memnon waited to welcome guests before leading them to the temple of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. You finish your Egyptian journey as you return to Cairo on the train from Luxor to continue your trip ahead. After exploring Luxor attractions, you should select your own activities until you in the evening.
