Overview

The 7-day family tour connects your family between historical sites and cultural destinations and peaceful relaxation. This <u>Egypt family vacation</u> starts with <u>Cairo</u>, which offers visitors the opportunity to see the Giza Pyramids alongside both the Grand Egyptian Museum and the Khan Al-Khalili Bazaar. During your time in <u>Aswan</u>, you should see the High Dam together with Philae Temple and the Unfinished Obelisk, followed by a relaxing Nile cruise experience. On your sailing <u>Egypt trip</u>, visit the temple sites at Kom Ombo and Edfu to learn about their ancient deities, who are revered by the gods. You can see all of the main Egyptian landmarks in a qualified and comfortable manner with this well-organized itinerary.

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Our representative will meet you at Cairo International Airport and drive you to your hotel in an air-conditioned car.

Accommodation: hotel in Cairo (1 night)

Meals: No meals included today.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids, Grand Egyptian Museum, and Khan Al-Khalili tour

After breakfast, your day starts with a meeting with your professional guide at your hotel for discovery throughout Giza's ancient sites. The <u>Giza Pyramids</u> are the starting point of your journey, which also includes visits to the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure. Since ancient times the <u>Great Sphinx</u> has provided protection to the pyramids through its pharaoh-faced statue, which rests upon a lion body form. Also, the Valley Temple offers visitors the opportunity to discover both ritual areas and mummification sites following their enjoyment of the breathtaking natural scenery.

After lunch, you continue your morning by heading to the <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u> (GEM), which houses artifacts from ancient Egypt and is one of the largest modern museums worldwide. Numerous dynastic royal treasures and large statues at the museum draw tourists who value the display of artifacts from various ancient eras. Visitors to <u>Khan el Khalili</u> bazaar can purchase handcrafted jewelry, artisanal arts, everyday tourist gifts, and both types of culinary spices.

Lunch at a local restaurant is included.

Accommodation: Hotel in Cairo (1 night)

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Day 3

Fly to Aswan – Aswan Tour & Check-in to Cruise

After breakfast, you're off to Cairo Airport to take a flight to Aswan. After landing, the next stop for you would be the <u>Aswan High Dam</u>, which is among the marvels of engineering in the world. This dam acts as the lifeblood of irrigation for most of Egypt, along with controlling the flow of water from the Nile River. From here you can enjoy the scenery of Lake Nasser, the largest artificial lake on earth.

Visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> and see the biggest known ancient obelisk, left in its quarry because of fissures.

Then, you will go to the sacred <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was transported to Agilkia Island after the construction of the High Dam. This temple will take you to a different world through its smooth reliefs, which narrate the ancient myths and legends of Egypt.

You will be served lunch in a local restaurant and transferred back to your Nile cruise for check-in and relaxation.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 4

Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples tour

Enjoy a time journey to Egypt's Greco-Roman period after breakfast, then continue on to Edfu Temple, which serves Horus as its patron deity and stands as one of the finest temples of Egypt because of its great pylon and carvings. Kom Ombo Temple represents a double temple in which a visitor can experience its worship of Horus alongside that of Sobek. At the end of the day, you will be transferred to Luxor.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 5

Luxor West Bank tour

You will proceed to the West Bank right after your lunch at a local restaurant in the region. Visit the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> in the West Bank to witness pharaoh tombs with preserved decorative wall paintings that survived great periods of time. You will visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, which rises like a masterpiece from the Deir el-Bahari cliffs to honor the powerful female Egyptian ruler. Decorated with colonnades, its terraces offer breathtaking views of the desert landscape. The Colossi

of Memnon, which consists of two massive statues that originally stood in front of Amenhotep III's mortuary temple, will be your final stop on your day trip.

Day 6

Luxor East Bank tour + return to Cairo

You will have breakfast before heading to Cairo Airport for the flight that will take you to Luxor to see Karnak Temple. You should see the largest religious complex dedicated to Amun-Ra in history. You can walk through the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 kolossi, the sacred lake, and obelisks. Then, Luxor Temple, a great building built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, is where the great colonnades stand with the Sphinxes Avenue.

Enjoy lunch services while relaxing on the Nile cruise.

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Final departure
