# Trip to explore Islamic Cairo sights

A comfortable hotel pickup enables your Cairo day tour to begin as your tour guide welcomes you to ride in a private air-conditioned vehicle.

## Citadel of Saladin & Mosque of Muhammad Ali

The Citadel of Saladin stands first on your agenda because it is a historic Islamic fortress that commands magnificent views across all of Cairo. The powerful structure constructed in the 12th century served both as Egypt's royal residence and protected the city of <a href="Cairo">Cairo</a> from attacks. The Mosque of Muhammad Ali, which people call Alabaster Mosque because of its white marble walls, is another stop inside the Citadel.

### **Sultan Hassan Mosque**

The Sultan Hassan Mosque stands as Cairo's largest and most renowned architectural mosque among all the mosques in the city. People have admired this mosque built in the 14th-century Mamluk period for its enormous dimensions and complex decorative details as well as its majestic Mamluk architectural design.

### Rifai Mosque

A short walk from the previous stop leads visitors to view the historical Rifai Mosque. The early twentieth-century mosque serves as both a burial place and an architectural landmark because royals from the Egyptian royal family are buried here.

#### Khan El Khalili Bazaar

Your guided journey will conclude at <u>Khan El Khalili Bazaar</u> following a visit to both mosques since this historical market has operated since the 14th century. Traverse the tight corridors throughout the Khan El Khalili Bazaar while admiring the stalls featuring Egyptian handicrafts such as handmade jewels alongside spices and fabrics along with memorabilia and numerous additional products.

Your driver will return you to your hotel after your <u>Egypt day tour</u> as a part of their professional service.
