Day 1

Giza attractions:

Visit the treasures of King Tutankhamun, including his legendary golden mask and a vast collection of statues, jewelry, and artifacts depicting Egypt's history.

Day 3

Flight to Luxor – Karnak & Luxor Temple

Karnak temple:

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo Domestic Airport for a Luxor day trip, the world's greatest open-air

museum. Visitors would start at Karnak Temple, which remains the biggest religious site from any

ancient time dedicated to Amun-Ra. Explore Hypostyle Hall and take in the 134 columns that rise high

above the floor, each adorned with hieroglyphics and bas-reliefs that allude to pharaonic devotion and

power.

Luxor temple:

Don't miss visiting Luxor Temple, which represents Egyptian architectural genius, situated in the

center of the city. The religious establishment served royal events and religious processions because

Amenhotep III and Ramses II were primarily involved in its construction. Enjoy Sphinx Avenue after

admiring the imposing statues and taking a stately stroll through the colonnade buildings. When your

exploration ends, you should return to your cruise boat, where you can enjoy the Nile continuing

ahead.

Optional Evening Activity:

Sound and Light Show at Karnak: Experience the magic of Karnak Temple illuminated at night, with a

captivating narration of its history.

Accommodation: Hotel in Luxor (1 night)

Meals: breakfast and lunch.

Day 4

Luxor Tours – Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

Valley of the kings:

Explore the West Bank of Luxor after breakfast, which is home to some of Egypt's best-known

archaeological sites. View the burial chambers of the Valley of the Kings to see where the most

important pharaohs, including Tutankhamun Ramses II and Seti I, were laid to rest. You can explore

opulent tombs decorated with rich hieroglyphics and Book of the Dead illustrations meant to guide

dead pharaohs to their afterlife.

Hatshepsut temple:

Next on the itinerary stands the marvelous Hatshepsut Temple, which stands gracefully near Deir el-

Bahari's cliff base. Queen Hatshepsut earned the distinction of being one of the scarce female Egyptian

pharaohs by whom the majestic temple was founded. Under this position, you can enjoy beautiful

desert views while imagining the grand pagan rituals that once took place at this location.

Colossi of memnon:

The Colossi of Memnon, two enormous statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III that stood 3,400 years ago

to welcome guests to his spacious mortuary temple, is the final stop for travelers in Luxor

before transfer to Hurghada by private air-conditioned vehicle.

Check into your hotel and enjoy the rest of the evening at leisure.

Accommodation: Hotel in Hurghada (1 night)

Meals: breakfast and lunch.

Day 5

Free day at Hurghada

After breakfast, enjoy a free day in Hurghada, a paradise on the Red Sea.

Optional activities:

Relax on pristine beaches and soak up the sun.

Accommodation: Hotel in Hurghada (1 night.)

Meals: breakfast only.

Day 6

Free day at Hurghada
