Giza Pyramids Complex

Step into an ageless land of Giza, the site of the last surviving wonder of the ancient world. The Pyramids of Giza are among the most extraordinary structures in human history, constructed around 2600 BC during Egypt's 4th dynasty. This archaeological site continues to captivate visitors with its timeless grandeur and mystery.

The Great Pyramid of Khufu

In the presence of the Great Pyramid built by the hand of man, wispy clouds may yet still form and dissipate in awe. Measured from the building of the king's chamber in granite to the deadliest of laws, it is 138 meters tall, erected by more than 2,300,000 blocks of limestone, with Khufu, the pharaoh, calling upon his architect Hemiunu; it remains the oldest and only one of the seven wonders of the

ancient world.

Great Sphinx

Meet the Great Sphinx, a mighty guardian carved with a lion's body and the face of Pharaoh Khafre.

For thousands of years, this splendid figure has stood for power and protection. Between its paws lies

the Dream Stele, erected by Thutmose IV in the fifteenth century BC.

The Valley Temple

This mortuary temple is where the mortuary cult would undergo ceremonies of purification, where the

pharaoh would be made ready for his passage into the afterlife through the actual ceremony of

"Opening of the Mouth."

Lunch with a View

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant with views of the Pyramids or the Nile, soaking in the

remarkable scenery.

The Egyptian Museum

Next, head to the heart of Cairo to visit the Egyptian Museum, a treasure trove of ancient artifacts.

Home to thousands of relics, including royal mummies and the treasures of King Tutankhamun, it's a

fascinating stop on your cultural journey.

Day 4

Nile Cruise Tour to Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Next, the cruise heads to majestic <u>Edfu Temple</u>, one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt. The temple is dedicated to Horus, the falcon god of protection. The walls show detailed reliefs depicting the epic battle scenes of ancient Egyptian civilization. Edfu Temple will be one of the highlights for the travelers exploring the Nile cruise between Aswan and Luxor.

Day 5
