Overview

Visitors can experience ancient Egyptian history by visiting the Grand Egyptian Museum and Old Cairo. You will fly to <u>Aswan</u>, where they can see the High Dam along with the Philae Temple before venturing on a Nile cruise, followed by seeing the West and East Banks of <u>Luxor</u>, including the Valley of Kings and Karnak Temple.

Visit <u>Hurghada</u> to experience paradise at the Red Sea while you choose to relax or try diving and other water recreational activities. The Egypt travel itinerary then leads you to <u>Alexandria</u> to see Pompey's Pillar and <u>Qaitbay Citadel</u> while also exploring the Catacombs. Take a chance to experience historical and cultural activities along with leisurely moments and investigative adventures with the luxury <u>Egypt family tour package</u>.

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Our representative will be welcoming and waiting for you in Egypt with a coordinated pick-up service to match the arrival time of your flight. He will have a sign with your name so that he is easily recognizable. You will be transported in your own private air-conditioned vehicle for a comfortable ride to your hotel.

Accommodation: Cairo hotel (1 night)

Day 2

Giza Pyramids, Saqqara & Memphis tour

After breakfast, set out for the magnificent tour of Egypt's ancient wonders.

Giza Pyramids:

Stand in front of the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the sole survivor of the wonders of the ancient world, during the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> tour, and discover the Pyramids of Khafre and Menkaure. You can also visit the Valley Temple of Khafre, where the royals were mummified.

Great Sphinx:

With the face of a pharaoh and the body of a lion, the <u>Great Sphinx</u> has stood for centuries guarding the pyramids.

Then, continue your Cairo historical tour to Saqqara and explore the

Step Pyramid of Djoser:

The oldest stone structure in the world, the <u>Step Pyramid of Djoser</u> includes tombs and a temple from the Old Kingdom of Egypt. Next, visit the ancient capital of Memphis and admire the colossal statue of Ramses II at the Open-Air Museum.

Lunch at a local restaurant is followed by returning to your hotel for the night.

Day 3

Tour to Grand Egyptian Museum, Cairo Citadel & Khan el Khalili

Breakfast will be served before continuing your exploration of Cairo's historic and cultural sites.

Grand Egyptian Museum:

Housing over 100,000 artifacts, the Grand Egyptian Museum showcases priceless treasures, including

the precious possessions of Tutankhamun.

Cairo Citadel:

Built during the 12th century by Salah al-Din, the Cairo Citadel offers the chance to see the

Mohammed Ali Mosque while enjoying breathtaking city views.

Khan el Khalili:

End your day by visiting Cairo's Khan el Khalili bazaar, which provides shopping opportunities as

well as a lively atmosphere for traditional crafts, jewelry, spices, and souvenirs.

You will go back to your hotel after eating lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Accommodation: a hotel in Cairo.

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Day 4

Fly to Aswan – Aswan tour with Nile cruise

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Cairo Airport for your flight to Aswan. Explore upon arrival;

Aswan High Dam:

The second destination is the Aswan High Dam, one of the engineering wonders of the world. It supplies most of Egypt with irrigation and controls the Nile River's water flow. From here, you can

admire the landscape of Lake Nasser, the largest artificial lake in the world.

Unfinished Obelisk:

See the largest known ancient obelisk, the Unfinished Obelisk, abandoned in its quarry due to cracks.

Then, you will visit the sacred

Philae Temple:

Moved to Agilkia Island after the construction of the High Dam to preserve it, the Philae Temple of Isis will transport you to another world with its beautiful reliefs, narrating the ancient myths and legends of Egypt.

Have a lunch at a local restaurant and then transfer back to your Nile cruise for check-in and relaxation.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 5

Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples tour

Sail to explore Kom Ombo temple while guests enjoy breakfast and prepare to visit the temples, which

celebrate the sacred deities Sobek and Horus.

Kom Ombo temple:

Kom Ombo temple sides, divided in the middle, boast distinctive architectural designs while sporting

distinct wall carvings, which tourists view in addition to the mummified crocodiles displayed at the

Crocodile Museum to gain a glimpse of ancient Egyptian sacred practices.

A boat transports passengers from the ship to the

Edfu Temple:

For breakfast, visit the Edfu Temple of Horus, a Ptolemaic architectural masterpiece that boasts

exquisite battle depictions of Horus engaged in combat with his enemies, all preserved in excellent

condition.

Sail to Luxor and enjoy a Galabia Party onboard in the evening.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Day 6

Luxor West Bank tour

After breakfast at a local eatery in the area, you will depart to explore the

Valley of the Kings:

On the list of the world's most famous archaeological sites, the Valley of the Kings served as the

ancient royal cemetery for New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including the most well-known,

Tutankhamun. With over sixty tombs—many richly decorated and carved deep into the rock with

symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers—this site was designed to guide pharaohs into the

afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

Beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut is one of

the most beautiful and well-preserved ancient Egyptian temples. This astounding mortuary temple was

built to honor one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. Its terraces, statues, and relief carvings reflect the

prosperity of her reign and her devotion to the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your

guide, you will hear the story of Hatshepsut—how she rose to power in a male-dominated world and

how her legacy continues to captivate historians and visitors alike.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, the Colossi of Memnon have watched over the gateway to the long-lost

mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters

(60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

At the end of your day, you will return to your cruise for lunch and sail to Edfu Temple. Enjoy

a Galabia Party on board in the evening.

Return to your cruise for lunch, followed by evening entertainment and dinner.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 7

Tour to Luxor East Bank tour + transfer to Hurghada

After breakfast, a private air-conditioned vehicle will take you to Cairo Airport, following which you will board your flight to Luxor, where your representative will greet you and take you to the private

A/C car that you will be using in making some of the most memorable and unforgettable experiences

of your Luxor day tour.

Karnak Temple:

Your journey begins at Karnak Temple, Egypt's largest temple complex, a UNESCO World Heritage

site. It is a remarkable area; you should look for the magnificent columns of the Hypostyle Hall and

read very specific and detailed texts about the reigns of many ancient pharaohs.

Luxor Temple:

Then continue to the Luxor Temple, guarded by the beautiful granite statues of Ramses II, which honor

the Theban Triad. After lunch at a local restaurant in the area, you will depart for the West Bank to

continue the luxury Egypt tour.

Accommodation: Hotel in Hurghada (1 night)

Day 8

Hurghada at Leisure

After breakfast, spend the day relaxing in Hurghada, the Red Sea paradise. You can choose from any

of the following optional activities:

Take a boat trip to Giftun Island for snorkeling and swimming.

After breakfast, drive to Cairo by private air-conditioned car. Check into your hotel and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

Day 11

Alexandria day tour

After your morning breakfast, take a Cairo to Alexandria private day tour to experience the Mediterranean beauty and historical sites of Alexandria by visiting first the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa. You can explore the historic burial site made of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman architectural elements. Pompey's Pillar stands as a remarkable Roman column, reaching a height of more than 25 meters.

Qaitbay Citadel, which was constructed in the 15th century, stands as one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World because it occupied the place of the Pharos Lighthouse. Experience a contemporary interpretation of the Alexandria Library, which presently contains thousands of books as well as cultural exhibits.
