Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

car for a smooth transfer to your hotel.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids & Grand Egyptian Museum

Giza attractions:

After having breakfast, you will connect with your professional guide at your hotel to start on a day of exploration at Giza's world-famous historic locations. Your adventure starts at the Giza Pyramids, where you will visit the Great Pyramid of Khufu along with the Pyramid of Khafre and the Pyramid of Menkaure. Witness the Great Sphinx, which stands as an ancient statue with a pharaoh's face on top of a lion's body, protecting the pyramids since ancient times. The Valley Temple stands as your next stop, where you can see places of ritual activity and mummification while taking in major scenic features of the impressive landscape.

Grand egyptian museum:

Enjoy a delicious lunch before continuing your family trip to the <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u> (GEM). All travelers must experience the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM), as it stands as among the biggest contemporary museums globally and serves to display ancient Egyptian relics. The museum houses a vast collection that includes statues while showcasing artifacts together with royal treasures across various dynasties. The museum displays Old Kingdom artifacts together with Middle Kingdom exhibits and New Kingdom treasures through pharaonic statues and flawless jewelry and household objects that recreate Egyptian daily life. The museum currently offers visitors exciting historical exploration through Egypt's lengthy and diverse past through its wide display areas and elaborate exhibition displays. You will be transferred back to your hotel after experiencing an unforgettable day.

Overnight in Cairo.

Meals: Lunch only.

The guests can join an optional evening activity that includes a dinner cruise on the Nile River featuring both traditional Egyptian food and live musical performances along with colorful folk

dancing under the Cairo sky.

Day 3

Travel to Luxor

Karnak temple:

After enjoying breakfast, you will be transferred by a private air-conditioned vehicle to Cairo Airport to take your flight to Luxor. Your tour guide at Luxor day trip airport will welcome you before using a private A/C vehicle to enjoy an extraordinary time throughout Luxor City. The East Bank of your journey starts with a visit to Karnak Temple, which is the biggest temple complex in Egypt and holds the status of a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its vast territory to see the impressive Hypostyle Hall columns and read detailed texts about the reigns of numerous ancient pharaohs.

Luxor temple:

After that, proceed to <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which is protected by Ramses II's exquisite granite statue, which also honors the Theban Triad. Visitors can achieve stunning photography results by standing under both the open courtyard and soaring obelisks of this temple. After lunch at a local restaurant in the area, you will depart for the West Bank to continue your Egypt trip.

Valley of the kings:

The <u>Valley of the Kings</u> on the West Bank allows you to tour the centuries-old pharaoh tombs featuring decorative wall artwork that remains visible despite its extensive age.

Hatshepsut temple:

You will visit the Temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, a soaring cliffside construction on the Deir el-Bahari cliffs honoring Egypt's powerful female ruler. You can discover the temple's magnificent terraces with their decorative colonnades to see the astonishing desert landscape panorama.

Colossi of memnon:

The Colossi of Memnon stand as two immense statues of Amenhotep III that were originally placed before his mortuary temple. At the end of the day, you will go back to the hotel.

Overnight in Luxor.

Meals: breakfast & lunch

Day 4

Transfer to Aswan

After breakfast, a private A/C vehicle will transfer you to the railway head for your onward trip to Aswan on the morning train. He will meet you at Aswan train station, and escort you to enjoy the city

tour in Aswan.

Aswan high dam:

The next stop will be the Aswan High Dam, one of the contemporary engineering wonders, which

mediates the flow of the Nile River and provides irrigation for most of Egypt. From here, you will

admire a panoramic view over Lake Nasser, the world's largest artificial lake.

Philae temple:

Then, you will visit the sacred Philae Temple of the goddess Isis. The entire complex of this temple

was transferred to Agilkia Island after the construction of the High Dam, so it was preserved. The

temple will take you into another world with its beautiful reliefs, depicting the ancient myths and

legends of Egypt.

Have lunch in a local restaurant, then transfer back to the hotel.

Overnight in Aswan.

Day 5

Abu Simbel tour

Abu simbel temple:

You will leave in the morning with our tour guide from your hotel in Aswan for a full-day trip to Abu

Simbel Temples, which is approximately 3 hours south beyond Aswan. You can find the magnificent

temples of Ramesses II and his queen, Nefertari, at Abu Simbel. These temples are cut into the

mountainside and famous for their massive pharaonic statues.

The Major Temple consists of four enormous entrance statues, each over 20 meters high and dedicated

to Ramesses ii. Inside, the walls depict scenes of numerous military victories of Ramesses. To equally

impressive is the Minor Temple, dedicated to Queen Nefertari, which also has six statues, all depicting

the queen with her husband and showcasing their powerful but harmonious juncture.

You will enjoy a local meal and will be taken to the Aswan Airport to board your flight back to Cairo.
