Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Day 2

Tour to Giza Pyramids, Grand Egyptian Museum & Khan Al-Khalili

A day of historical exploration at Giza's ancient sites begins immediately after your breakfast with a connection to your professional guide at your hotel. Your journey begins at the

Giza Pyramids:

Explore the grand Great Pyramid of Khufu, the [Giza Pyramids](#) tour, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure.

Great Sphinx:

With the face of a pharaoh and the body of a lion, the [Great Sphinx](#) has stood for millennia guarding the pyramids.

After lunch, you continue your Cairo day tour by going to the

Grand Egyptian Museum:

One of the biggest contemporary museums in the world, the [Grand Egyptian Museum](#) tour showcases ancient Egyptian artifacts and is a must-see for visitors. Its extensive collection includes statues and

royal treasures from different dynastic periods, offering a remarkable journey through Egypt's history.

Then, proceed on your Cairo walking tour to the

Khan el Khalili:

In the heart of Cairo, the Islamic Cairo walking tour and [Khan el Khalili](#) traditional bazaar offer patrons the chance to buy handcrafted jewelry, artwork, aromatic spices, and customary mementos. Step into the vibrant atmosphere of one of the oldest markets in the Middle East.

Lunch at a local restaurant is included.

Day 3

Fly to Luxor – Luxor East Bank tour

Eat breakfast before moving to Cairo Airport to board the flight that will take you to a Luxor day trip, which stands as the largest outdoor historical complex on Earth.

Karnak Temple:

Visitors can access the biggest religious complex in history, the [Karnak Temple](#), which reveres Amun-Ra. They can roam through the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 colossal columns and explore both the sacred lake and the towering obelisks.

Luxor Temple:

Standing as a magnificent structure, the [Luxor Temple](#) was built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, featuring grand colonnades alongside the Sphinx Avenue.

Enjoy lunch services while relaxing on the Nile cruise.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 4

Luxor West Bank trip & Sail to Edfu Temple

You will go to the West Bank just after your lunch in one of the local restaurants in the area. You can see the tombs of pharaohs at the

Valley of the Kings:

On the list of the world's most famous archaeological sites, the [Valley of the Kings](#) served as the ancient royal cemetery for New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including the most well-known, Tutankhamun. With over sixty tombs—many richly decorated and carved deep into the rock with symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers—this site was designed to guide pharaohs into the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

Beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri, the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) is one of the most beautiful and well-preserved ancient Egyptian temples. This astounding mortuary temple was built to honor one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. Its terraces, statues, and relief carvings reflect the prosperity of her reign and her devotion to the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your guide, you will hear the story of Hatshepsut—how she rose to power in a male-dominated world and how her legacy continues to captivate historians and visitors alike.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, [the Colossi of Memnon](#) have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

At the end of your day, you will return to your cruise for lunch and sail to Edfu Temple. Enjoy a Galabia Party on board in the evening.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 5

Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples trip

Enjoy a time journey to Egypt's Greco-Roman period following your breakfast, and then proceed to

Edfu Temple:

Serving Horus as its patron deity, the [Edfu Temple](#) stands as one of Egypt's finest temples, renowned for its impressive pylon and detailed carvings.

Temple of Kom Ombo:

Visitors can explore the temple dedicated to Horus and Sobek, the [Temple of Kom Ombo](#), where these gods were once worshiped.

Guests are taken from Sohag to Aswan for a memorable dinner cruise experience in the evening.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 6

Aswan City Tour

Breakfast is complete, then you join a flight from Cairo Airport to Aswan. You will arrive at the

Aswan High Dam:

Immediately after touching down, visit the [Aswan High Dam](#), one of the world's most spectacular feats of human engineering. The High Dam provides irrigation water across most of Egypt and ensures Nile River water management. From here, you can take in breathtaking views of Lake Nasser, the world's largest artificial water reservoir.

Unfinished Obelisk:

Experience the largest known ancient obelisk at the [Unfinished Obelisk](#) in its original quarry space, where it remained because of its splitting characteristics.

Philae Temple:

Relocated to Agilkia Island following the construction of the High Dam, the [Philae Temple](#) features smooth reliefs depicting ancient Egyptian myths and legends, creating a completely different world. You will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before checking into your Nile cruise for rest and enjoyment.

Check in at your Nile cruise before settling down for a period of rest.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 7

Disembarkation – Return to Cairo

After having breakfast, leave your cruise and transfer to Aswan Airport for a flight to Cairo to rest in your hotel.

Abu Simbel Temples:

Explore the gigantic temples built by Ramses II, the [Abu Simbel Temples](#), dedicated to himself and his queen, Nefertari. Enjoy the magnificent statues and detailed carvings that capture the splendor of

ancient Egypt.

Accommodation: Hotel in Cairo (1 night)

Meals: breakfast & lunch.

Final departure

After the breakfast, you will be leaving for the Cairo airport, as our tour guide fluffs the last chapter to the perfect land of the Pyramids, signing your Egypt Family tours experience.
