Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Day 3

Walk through the impressive Hypostyle Hall with its 134 towering columns, admire the obelisks and sacred lake, and take in the intricate religious and pharaonic art. After your visit, enjoy your free time to further explore Luxor

Day 4

Visit the Valley of the Kings + transfer to Aswan

After breakfast, start the day with a journey across the Nile to the Valley of the Kings.

Valley of the Kings:

Among the world's most renowned archaeological sites, the [Valley of the Kings](#) stands as the ancient royal cemetery of Egypt's New Kingdom pharaohs, including the famous Tutankhamun. With over sixty tombs carved deep into the rock—adorned with symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers—this valley was designed to guide pharaohs into the afterlife. Philae Temple:

Relocated to Agilkia Island after the construction of the High Dam, [Philae Temple](#) captivates visitors with its smooth reliefs depicting ancient Egyptian myths and legends, transporting you to another world. After your visit, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before checking into your Nile cruise for some rest and relaxation

Nubian Village:

It was relocated to save it from the rising waters of Lake Nasser. The temple was genuinely devoted to the goddess Isis and would provide a representative sense of the religion practiced by ancient Egypt, in addition to offering a breathtaking view of its magnificent columns and exquisite carvings. You can spend the afternoon relaxing before heading to [Nubian Village](#) in the evening to have dinner with a local family and experience their gracious hospitality.
