Overview

Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Welcome to <u>Cairo</u>, the first step of your luxury Egypt trip. Upon arrival at Cairo Airport, our tour guide will meet and assist you and transfer you to your hotel.

Day 2

Tour to Grand Egyptian Museum, Giza Pyramids and Sphinx

The tour guide and private driver will greet you and search for a hotel while traveling along, pointing out important sights of Egypt during your Cairo sightseeing tours.

Grand Egyptian Museum:

Your tour guide and private driver will greet you at the airport upon your arrival, and then take you to your hotel, showing you Cairo's key landmarks along the way during your sightseeing tour. One of the major highlights is the <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u>, the largest archaeological museum in the world. The museum boasts over 100,000 pharaonic artifacts to display the great richness of ancient Egyptian history. Guests, particularly from all around the globe, come to see the legendary treasures of King Tutankhamun, including the golden death mask and gilded sarcophagi, as well as the gigantic statues of Ramses II. Your guide will tell you every mystical fact about the treasures, their discovery, and their importance both culturally and historically in the past of Egypt.

Giza Pyramids:

On the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, visitors have the opportunity to visit the wonderful Pyramid of Khafre and the smaller Pyramid of Menkaure. Amidst spectacular desert vistas, you will enjoy a camel ride through the sands while being told about how the ancient Egyptians mysteriously built these timeless wonders. Such an immersive experience brings the two worlds together as you walk in the footsteps of the pharaohs.

The Great Sphinx:

Just next to the pyramids, you find the iconic <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a monumental statue with the body of a lion and the head of a human. It has kept watch over the plateau for thousands of years and is thought to symbolize valor, wisdom, and royal power. Your guide will take you through its symbolism and historical purpose as one of the most mysterious and awe-inspiring monuments of Egypt.

Immediate transport back to your hotel at the end of a full day of discovery will allow well-merited rest.

Day 3

Travel to Aswan

In the early dawn, our tour guide would take you to the Cairo airport for a short flight to Aswan, a beautiful city of stunning sights and history. when arriving, you will start on a journey to explore the city along with your tour guide, including visits to some of its main attractions. visit the:

Philae Temple:

To protect the temple from the flooding Nile water levels, it was shifted to Agilkia Island. During the visit, cruise around the <u>Philae Temple</u>, and the guide will explain the historical significance of its magnificent pylons and draw attention to beautiful carvings and peaceful colonnades. Consecrated to the goddess Isis, the Temple of Isis is among the finest treasures of history in all of Egypt.

Then, you will be escorted to your hotel for check-in and to relax a bit. The tour guide will meet you at the hotel lobby, and the luxury <u>Egypt tour</u> will begin on a traditional wooden felucca sailing slowly along the Nile River. Take it all in the calm waters of the river, lush green land, and stunning sunsets, enhancing an incredible moment of relaxing coziness with nature, and then experience Nubian culture after dinner with a Nubian family. You will transfer to the hotel at the end of your trip.

Day 4

Abu Simbel Temples (Optional tour)

Spend a whole day discovering Aswan, whether wandering around the city, visiting the local bazaars, or taking one option out of many excursions. Your first stop will be

Abu Simbel Temples (Optional tour):

Ramses II ordered the construction of the stunning <u>Abu Simbel temples</u> with mountain cave carvings that honor his authority and respect divine beings. Marvel at the four giant statues of Ramses II that secure the Great Temple, then examine the interior chambers with their magnificent bas-reliefs. Your guide will share important information about how engineers saved the temple from flooding by relocating it. Your driver will take you to Aswan to transfer you to your luxury Nile cruise.

Lake Nasser:

Created by the amalgamation created through the construction of the Aswan High Dam, this vast artificial lake stretches across southern Egypt and northern Sudan. <u>Lake Nasser</u> serves the purposes of irrigation, hydroelectric power, and flood control, alongside some phenomenal desert scenery. It is also a corridor to monuments like the temples of Abu Simbel.

Take a peaceful walk along the Aswan Corniche to enjoy the beautiful views of the Nile River and colorful surroundings. Enjoy the tranquil surroundings of the river while observing the traditional feluccas during your luxury Egypt tour. Your tour guide will be happy to help with more information on what local places serve food and other activities.

Day 5

Head to Luxor + Visit Karnak Temple

After breakfast, you will be picked up by your driver and tour guide for a 4-5 hour drive to Luxor, one of Egypt's most famous historical sites. Once there, you will go to the hotel to rest for a bit before you start your Luxor tour and head to:

Karnak Temple:-

One of the largest and most beautiful temple complexes in Egypt, the Karnak Temple reigns supreme when it comes to the great rows of columns with wonderful hieroglyphic inscription and, conversely, massive halls. It is mainly dedicated to Amun, the temple offers the fruits of the ancient Egyptian civilization's architecture and art should not be missed by the visitor to Luxor.

Having finished your luxury trip in Egypt, you will be taken back to your hotel for the night.

Optional Activity: Luxor Temple at sundown

Day 6

Visit the Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple & Colossi of Memnon

Our tour guide will take you on a journey through Luxor's outstanding archaeological treasures just after breakfast. Explore Egypt's royal and religious history while visiting the

Valley of the Kings:

Known as the royal necropolis of Egypt's pharaohs, the site has once again become famous for the elaborate tholos tombs carved into the desert hills. The Valley of the Kings is famous for its fine paintings on the walls and for treasures that inform us about ancient Egyptian concepts of the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

You will see the temple terraces at <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> while your guide tells the story of how she became the first woman pharaoh in the history of Egypt.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, the Colossi of Memnon have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

After your Egypt tour, you will be taken back to your hotel to rest.

Day 7

Fly Back to Cairo & Explore Islamic Cairo

An early morning flight to Aswan for a short flight back to Cairo with a tour guide to pick you up. Afterwards, enjoy exploring the fascinating history and culture behind <u>Islamic Cairo</u> while visiting some of its most renowned landmarks. First, visit the

Islamic Cairo:

<u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, This is a medieval fortress having one of the most iconic statuses in Egypt. Built in the 12th century by the great Muslim leader Salah al-Din (Saladin) to defend Cairo from Crusader attacks, the citadel later became the seat of government of the rulers of Egypt for over 700 years., The <u>Mohamed Ali Mosque</u>, enjoy your Egyptian lunch at a local restaurant.

<u>Al-Moez Street</u> is one of Cairo's oldest streets, where local life is vibrant and there are many examples of well-preserved Islamic architecture and marketplaces. Explore a traditional Egyptian market that is teeming with activity and joy, select a memento that appeals to you, and then fully engage with the culture.

At the end of your Cairo Islamic tour, you'll be transferred back to your hotel for the evening.

Optional Activity: Dinner on a Cairo Nile River cruise.

Final Departure

The adventure has now come to an end, and with an eternal memory of Egypt in your heart, you will resume your flight back home.
