Day 2

It is possible to step into the world's largest archaeological museum on a [grand Egyptian museum](#) tour and learn about the ancient history of Egypt while admiring over 100,000 artifacts. Here are the world-renowned Golden Mask of King Tutankhamun, gilded sarcophagi, and colossal statues of Ramses II. Your guide will tell you every enchanting tale of these treasures, how they were uncovered, and their significance in Egypt's glorious history. After which, you will be taken to the

Giza Pyramids:

On the Cairo tour to the [Giza pyramids](#), visitors have the opportunity to visit the pyramids of Giza from Cairo, including the wonderful Pyramid of Khafre and the smaller Pyramid of Menkaure. Day 3

Philae Temple :

To safeguard it from the flooding Nile water levels, [Philae Temple](#) was relocated to Agilkia Island. During your visit, cruise around Philae Temple with your guide, who will explain the historical value of its magnificent pylons while pointing out beautiful carvings and peaceful colonnades. The temple of Isis stands among the most beautiful historical locations in Egypt, following its dedication to Isis.

Nubian village :

A scenic boat ride in the evening will take you to a [Nubian village](#) to explore its vibrant streets and local markets while dining with a Nubian family. Chat with Nubians as you learn about their heritage through conversation, along with trying authentic Nubian food. End your day with relaxing moments at your hotel before calling it a night.

Day 4

Optional Abu Simbel & Board the Nile Cruise

The morning can begin with peaceful relaxation before the Egypt trip to

Abu Simbel Temples:

Ramses II ordered the construction of the stunning [Abu Simbel temples](#) with mountain cave carvings that honor his authority and respect divine beings. Marvel at the four giant statues of Ramses II that secure the Great Temple, then examine the interior chambers with their magnificent bas-reliefs. Your guide will share important information about how engineers saved the temple from flooding by relocating it. Your driver will take you to Aswan to transfer you to your luxury Nile cruise.

Day 5

Explore Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

After breakfast, the next course of action will be sailing on the Nile to visit two wondrous temples with yet different comments on ancient Egyptian religion.

Kom Ombo Temple:

[Kom Ombo](#) is a unique double-temple to be used by the heavenly falcon (Horus) and the crocodile (Sobek). Watch the double set-up, visit the Crocodile Mummification Museum to look at the mummified crocodiles, and listen to your guide explain the symbolism behind these gods in ancient Egypt.

Temple of Edfu:

Next up is the [Temple of Edfu](#), the place to be passed on horseback. From the gigantic pylons to the holy sanctuary and its embossments-which narrate the astrological fight between Horus and Seth-gets into antique Egyptian storytelling and artistry to be unraveled by your guide.

In the evening, drive back to your Nile cruise after the [Egypt tour](#).

Day 6

Sail to Luxor & Visit Karnak Temple

The Nile cruise boat continues through the Esna Locks directly to Luxor. You will visit Karnak Temple, which dates back over 200 years in its construction.

Karnak Temple:

Considered among the world's largest temple complexes and hence worthy of its titles, [Karnak Temple](#) is known for its gigantic columns, innumerable hieroglyphics, and spacious halls. The major gods worshiped here include Amun, and the temple became symbolic of ancient Egyptian thunder while testifying to the architectural and artistic triumphs of their civilization. This is, therefore, a pleasant must-see spot in Luxor.

Day 7

Explore the Valley of the Kings & West Bank

Your cruise ship stops to allow you to visit Luxor's West Bank sites, accompanied by a guide, where you can admire more than 60 chambers of the pharaohs' tombs nestled within the bare cliffs of the

Valley of the Kings:

Known as the royal necropolis of Egypt's pharaohs, the site has once again become famous for the elaborate tholos tombs carved into the desert hills. [The Valley of the Kings](#) is famous for its fine paintings on the walls and for treasures that inform us about ancient Egyptian concepts of the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

You will see the temple terraces at [Queen Hatshepsut](#) while your guide tells the story of how she became the first woman pharaoh in the history of Egypt.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, [the Colossi of Memnon](#) have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

After your Egypt tour, you will be taken back to your hotel to rest.

The hotel provides return transportation after the completion of your [Egypt tour package](#).

Day 8

Fly to Cairo & Visit Islamic Cairo

Our tour guide will be with you early in the morning to transfer you to Aswan Airport for a short flight to Cairo, after which you will spend some time exploring the fascinating history and culture of [Islamic Cairo](#) with a few typical historical sites during the Cairo Islamic tour. Enjoy walking in the

Karnak Temple:-

A lively market in the core of Islamic Cairo, [Khan al-Khalili Bazaar](#) glitters under the vibrant atmosphere filled with traditional crafts, spices, jewelry, and souvenirs. The bazaar is alive with culture and glory; it is an experience where one can buy treasures with an aura of history and walk with a feeling of being grounded in local ethnography.

Al-Azhar Mosque:-

Then, head to [Al-Azhar Mosque](#), Then, head to one of the leading masterpieces of Islamic architecture, established in the 10th century. View beautiful minarets, detailed interiors, and a courtyard worth visiting. Thus, you will be invited to a local family dinner where everyone eats together with lots of heartwarming tales, learning many aspects of modern living in Egypt.
