Day 1

Day 1- Vip welcome at cairo airport & effortless hotel check-in

Your flight manager meets you at <u>Cairo</u> International Airport. He will help you finalize the required formalities at the airport. He will then escort you to the hotel in a private, air-conditioned luxury vehicle. At the hotel, your tour manager helps you check in smoothly and then reviews your vacation package itinerary with you to reconfirm the meeting times for each tour and activity in preparation for

the start of your Egypt Luxury Tour. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2

Day 2-Explore the wonders of giza & the grand egyptian museum

After a healthy and hearty breakfast at the hotel, your guide will take you to the Giza Plateau to initiate your visit, marveling at one of the Seven Wonders of the World

Grand Egyptian Museum:

Your tour guide and private driver will greet you at the airport upon your arrival, and then take you to your hotel, showing you Cairo's key landmarks along the way during your sightseeing tour. One of the major highlights is the Grand Egyptian Museum, the largest archaeological museum in the world. The museum boasts over 100,000 pharaonic artifacts to display the great richness of ancient Egyptian history. Guests, particularly from all around the globe, come to see the legendary treasures of King Tutankhamun, including the golden death mask and gilded sarcophagi, as well as the gigantic statues of Ramses II. Your guide will tell you every mystical fact about the treasures, their discovery, and their importance both culturally and historically in the past of Egypt.

Giza Pyramids:

On the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, visitors have the opportunity to visit the wonderful Pyramid of Khafre and the smaller Pyramid of Menkaure. Amidst spectacular desert vistas, you will enjoy a camel ride through the sands while being told about how the ancient Egyptians mysteriously built these timeless wonders. Such an immersive experience brings the two worlds together as you walk in the footsteps of the pharaohs.

The Great Sphinx:

Just next to the pyramids, you find the iconic <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a monumental statue with the body of a lion and the head of a human. It has kept watch over the plateau for thousands of years and is thought to symbolize valor, wisdom, and royal power. Your guide will take you through its symbolism and historical purpose as one of the most mysterious and awe-inspiring monuments of Egypt. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3

Day 3-Museum of Egyptian Civilization, Old Cairo & Salah El-Din Citadel

After a hearty Egyptian breakfast, you will be driven to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, where you will see royal mummies and an astonishing collection that tells the great, diverse history of Egypt. From there, From there, continue your luxury Egypt tour and transfer first to Old Cairo, where some of the oldest standing churches in the country will be visited. After a tasty lunch at a local restaurant, continue the historical exploration by visiting

Islamic cairo:

Citadel of Saladin, This is a medieval fortress having one of the most iconic statuses in Egypt. Built in the 12th century by the great Muslim leader Salah al-Din (Saladin) to defend Cairo from Crusader attacks, the citadel later became the seat of government of the rulers of Egypt for over 700 years. The Mohamed Ali Mosque, enjoy your Egyptian lunch at a local restaurant.

Overnight in Cairo.

Visits: National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, Old Cairo, Salah El-Din Citadel.

Day 4

Day 4-Fly Cairo to Luxor

Check out of your hotel in the morning. Transfer to Cairo airport for a domestic flight to Luxor. Your tour manager will meet you at the airport in Luxor and take you by air-conditioned car to your hotel for check-in. and to prepare for the start of your Luxor tour.

Day 5

Day 5-Nile Cruise - Tours in Luxor

After breakfast, check out of the hotel in the morning. Transfer to start the Egypt Nile cruise in Luxor trip. Enjoy lunch on board your motor ship on the Nile. Start your tours in Luxor with the East Bank of

the Nile to visit.

Karnak Temple:

Wander inside this large temple complex, Karnak Temple, which is a testament to ancient Egypt's glory. Explore the colossal Hypostyle Hall, a sacred lake, and wonderful carved pictures depicting the

story of pharaohs and gods.

Luxor Temple:

The Luxor Temple is an impressive monument of the past, once acting as an epicenter for religious and ceremonial life in Thebes, the capital of ancient Egypt. Many temples stand for a specified god; however, Luxor Temple was mostly concerned with the rejuvenation of kingship and was a major component of the Opet Festival, where the statues of the gods Amun, Mut, and Khonsu were conveyed

from Karnak to Luxor.

Dinner and overnight on the cruise ship.

Having finished your luxury trip in Egypt, you will be taken back to your hotel for the night.

Optional tour: to enjoy sound and light performances at Karnak Temple.

Day 6

Day 6-Nile Cruise - Tours in Luxor

After breakfast, enjoy the magnificent Luxor trip to the royal tombs of the 62 Pharaohs

Valley of the Kings:

On the list of the world's most famous archaeological sites, the Valley of the Kings stands out as an

ancient royal cemetery for the New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including the most well-known king,

Tutankhamun. There are over sixty tombs within the valley—and more still being discovered—all

varying in decoration. These tombs were carved deep into the rock, adorned with symbolic artwork,

hieroglyphs, and secret chambers intended to assist the pharaohs in their journey to the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

One of the most beautiful and well-preserved of ancient Egyptian temples, the Temple of Queen

Hatshepsut is an astounding mortuary temple built to honor one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. The

terraces, statues, and relief carvings of the temple mark the prosperity of her reign and her devotion to

the god Amun. As you walk through the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut with your guide, you will be

taught the story of Hatshepsut—how she came to power in a male-dominated world, and how her

legacy still captivates historians and visitors alike. The temple is beautifully set against the dramatic

cliffs of Deir el-Bahri.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, the Colossi of Memnon have watched over the gateway to the long-lost

mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters

(60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

Overnight aboard the Nile Cruise.

Day 7

Day 7-Nile Cruise - The Temples of Edfu and Kom Ombo

Enjoy your breakfast in the morning. Lunch will be served on board to enjoy an Egypt luxury trip by

Edfu and kom ombo temples:

the Temple of Horus in Edfu. Then visit the temple shared by two gods, Sobek and Horus, in Kom Ombo. Return to the ship and enjoy afternoon tea while sailing to Aswan. Dinner and overnight on board.

Unfinished obelisk:

Philae Temple:

Dedicated to the goddess Isis, Philae Temple is an excellently preserved site that was relocated to Agilkia Island to save it from being submerged in water. While exploring Philae Temple, get fascinated by the well-carved sculptures and learn their historical context. Dinner and overnight aboard the Nile cruise.

Day 9 - Optional tour of Abu Simbel

Abu simbel temple:

Enjoy your breakfast on the Nile cruise, then go to your hotel for check-in for a one-night stay. Optional trip to <u>Abu Simbel Temples</u>: about 3 and a half hours. From Aswan to Abu Simbel with a private air-conditioned car. when your arrival at Abu Simbel, enjoy the impressive temples of

Ramses II at Abu Simbel, dedicated to the four world gods of: Ptah, Reharakhetty, Amun-Rey, and Ramses II.

Day 10 - Aswan - Cairo - Back home

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. You will be transferred to <u>Aswan</u> Airport to fly to Cairo. It's time at Cairo International Airport for your final departure after your luxury Egypt tour.
