Day 1

Arrival to Cairo

Day 2

Cairo sightseeing tour

Your Red Sea tour package begins on the Giza Plateau, where you will see the

Giza Pyramids:

<u>Giza Pyramids</u> tour, where you'll explore the grand Great Pyramid of Khufu, Pyramid of Khafre, and Pyramid of Menkaure.

Great Sphinx:

Marvel at the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, the ancient statue with the body of a lion and the face of a pharaoh, which has been guarding these pyramids for thousands of years. Here you also visit the Valley Temple - the setting for many rituals and mummifications—for stunning views of this incredible landscape, making it an unforgettable part of your Egypt honeymoon tour.

Day 3

Travel to Luxor

Valley of the Kings:

<u>Valley of the Kings</u> On the list of the world's most famous and then some archaeological sites, it is also an ancient royal cemetery for the New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including that most well-known king, Tutankhamun. There are over sixty tombs within the valley and more being made, all of which have various degrees of decoration and were carved deep into the rock with symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers intended to assist these pharaohs in entering the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, one of the most beautiful and well-preserved of ancient Egyptian temples. this astounding mortuary temple was built for the purpose of honoring one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. The terraces, statues, and relief carvings of the temple mark the prosperity of her reign and her devotion to the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your guide, you will be taught the story of Hatshepsut; how she came to power in a male-dominated world, and how her legacy still captivates historians and visitors alike. beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri. Also,

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, the Colossi of Memnon have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

After your Luxor tour, you will be taken back to your hotel to rest.

Day 4

Visit Karnak and Luxor Temple

You will start your day with a delicious breakfast at your hotel, setting up for another exciting day of exploration. Next, you will have the opportunity to visit one of Egypt's most magnificent temples,

Karnak Temple

<u>Karnak Temple</u>, Wander through this vast complex dedicated to the god Amun-Ra. Marvel at the Hypostyle Hall, a forest of 134 towering columns, and the sacred lake.

Luxor Temple

<u>Luxor Temple</u>, Admire this stunning temple built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, featuring grand colonnades and the Avenue of Sphinxes.

After this Luxor day trip, you'll depart for Hurghada's azure shores.

Free day at Hurghada

Enjoy your free day at Hurghada by diving, taking a glass boat, going on a safari, snorkeling, or taking a submarine. Egypt trips are available upon request.
