Itinerary

Day 1

Welcome to Aswan – Explore High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple

When you arrive at the Aswan train station or airport, an Egypt Tours representative will greet you and give you your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide. Your Luxor and Aswan Nile cruise trip starts with a visit to the [Aswan High Dam](#) and then an adjacent [Unfinished Obelisk](#), where you will learn ancient

techniques of stone carving before taking a quick ride on a boat taking you to the wonderful [Philae Temple](#), as the goddess Isis dedicated to the peaceful island. After your Egypt tour, you will take total comfort in your luxurious Nile cruise boat in Aswan, bringing you delicious food and afternoon tea while relaxing as you prepare to spend a memorable night on board.

Day 2

Visit Temples of Kom Ombo & Edfu + Sailing the Nile

Begin by enjoying breakfast on deck while the Luxor Aswan Nile cruise sails toward [Kom Ombo Temple](#), taking in some amazing views of the modern Aswan Bridge and the serene Nile countryside. Then, your Egypt Day Trips guide will direct you to the interesting Kom Ombo Temple of Sobek and Horus at Kom Ombo, an unusual double temple dedicated to two gods.

After returning to your boat, you will eat lunch as the ship makes its way to [Edfu Temple](#). After arrival, you will visit the fantastic Temple of Horus, which is dedicated to the falcon-headed god and considered one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt. Afternoon tea is then served on the upper deck while cruising on towards Luxor and through the Esna Lock, a wonderful opportunity to see and photograph some local life. After sailing into Luxor, you will spend the night on the cruise and savor a delicious meal.

Day 3

Visit East bank of Luxor + Karnak & Luxor Temples

Savor the delicious breakfast as the Nile cruise pulls into the historic city of Luxor. You will spend the entire morning exploring the East Bank, where you will see the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), regarded as one of the best examples of ancient Egyptian architecture, and the expansive [Karnak Temple](#), a complex with tall columns and holy statues. Your Nile cruise from Luxor to Aswan continues with an eventual return for a leisurely lunch followed by afternoon tea. For the rest of the day, use the time according to your own wishes, wandering around Luxor or relaxing on board, soaking up the fantastic views of this historic city.

Dinner is served on board and is to be the last overnight stay on board the cruise.

Day 4

Head to West Bank of Luxor – Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

After enjoying breakfast aboard, get off the ship to tour an entire West Bank with a guide that takes guests to the world-renowned [Valley of the Kings](#), with grand tombs where once-resting pharaohs were exquisitely buried. Then, it is on to the impressive [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), an amazing structure carved into the cliffs of Deir el-Bahari. Finally, stop at the great [Colossi of Memnon](#), two giant statues that stand guard at the remains of a once magnificent temple.

Day 1

Luxor East Bank – Welcome to the Land of Pharaohs

Your Nile cruise Luxor Aswan trip begins with a warm greeting from an Egypt Day Trips representative at Luxor Airport or the train station. An experienced Egyptologist will then introduce you to an enigmatic experience guided by the itinerary of Luxor's East Bank: the grandeur of [Karnak Temple](#), an extensive area of sanctuaries and massive columns, and [Luxor Temple](#), the beautiful facade of construction along the river. Then, you will board a 5-star Nile cruise ship and enjoy lunch, afternoon tea, and dinner before departing from Luxor to Aswan, where you will enjoy the sunset views along the Nile.

Optional: Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple.

Meals: lunch & dinner.

Day 2

Luxor West Bank – Valley of the Kings & Scenic Sailing

Start the day with a hearty breakfast and sail onward to the West Bank of Luxor, where it is said history begins. Visit the [Valley of the Kings](#), a remarkable burial site, with its elaborately decorated tombs of the pharaohs; the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), a majestic temple built on the cliffs at Deir el-Bahari; and the immortal [Colossi of Memnon](#), stone giants that keep watch over this ancient past.

Head back to the Luxor Aswan Nile cruise, where you can relax while sailing to Edfu via the entrancing Esna Lock-walk down memory lane, taking ace photos while observing Nile-side life. Enjoy a delectable dinner on board as the boat gets ready at Esna.

Day 3

Edfu & Kom Ombo – Temples of Horus and Sobek

Have your breakfast, followed by a trip to the Temple of Horus in [Edfu](#), one of the best-preserved temples of ancient Egypt. Marvel at its immense architecture and learn about the falcon-headed god Horus! Return to the ship and have a relaxed lunch as it sets sail for Kom Ombo.

Upon arrival, your guide will take you to the [Kom Ombo Temple](#), a unique double temple dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus, the falcon god. Return to the Luxor Aswan Nile cruise and enjoy dinner as the boat continues sailing to Aswan, passing under the Aswan Bridge and with beautiful views of the Tombs of the Nobles in the night sky.

Overnight on a cruise.

Meals: breakfast, lunch & dinner.

Day 4

Aswan City Tour – High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple

After breakfast, the day turns wild in Aswan. Now, the Egyptologist guide will show you three well-known sites. See the revered temple of Philae, devoted to the goddess Isis, charmingly situated on an

island; the [High Dam](#), a symbol of contemporary engineering; and the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), a window into ancient stone carving.

After lunch on the Nile cruise Luxor Aswan cruise, which should be a delicious affair, there will be tea in the afternoon and plenty of time to relax and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of Aswan.

Day 5

Check Out – Explore Aswan or Optional Abu Simbel Adventure

After going through breakfast, rather than disembarking from the cruise and moving on to free time for the day, you'll explore Aswan at your own pace. Spending the time gazing at the lively Nubian markets or just relaxing and taking in the beauty of this city are two possible activities. Besides more than returning to Aswan, it should be marveled upon by the huge statues of King Ramses II and being very elegant at the temple dedicated to Queen Nefertari. You will be left with life's memories as you spend the remainder of the day traveling to the Aswan airport or train station.

Optional: Take a private vehicle or a short flight with EgyptAir on one of the most suggested tours to the famous [Abu Simbel Temples](#).
