Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

Beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri, the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) is one of the most beautiful and well-preserved ancient Egyptian temples. This mortuary temple was built for one of the very few women to hold the royal title of pharaoh in the land of the Nile. Its terraces, its statues, and its relief carvings speak much of the wealth she enjoyed during her reign and her love for the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your guide, you will hear the story of Hatshepsut—how she came to power in a male world, and how her memory continues to fascinate historians and tourists.

Colossi of Memnon:

For over 3,000 years, the [Colossi of Memnon](#) have watched over what remains of the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile, close to Luxor. At approximately 18 meters (60 feet) high, each colossus is made of a single block of sandstone.
