### Day 1

Your journey will begin with a visit to the great [Aswan High Dam](#) and then the [Unfinished Obelisk](#), where you will find out how stones were carved by the ancient Egyptians. Then, take a short boat ride to the enchanting Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis and situated on a peaceful island.

After your outing, you will leave on board your upscale Nile cruise boat at Aswan for lunch, afternoon tea, and an unforgettable overnight stay.

## Day 2

### Temples of Kom Ombo & Edfu – Sailing the Nile

Start the day with breakfast onboard while the cruise navigates towards [Kom Ombo](#), providing fine views of the new Aswan Bridge and the serene Nile landscape. In Kom Ombo, the guide will lead you to the magnificent Temple of Sobek and Hieroris, a rare double temple dedicated to two deities.

Return on board for a luxurious lunch as you sail to Edfu. Here, explore the stunning [Temple of Horus](#), Egypt's most well-preserved temple, dedicated to the falcon-headed god. Take afternoon tea on the sun deck as the cruise continues to Luxor via the Esna Lock - a great time to observe daily life around us and take nostalgic souvenir photos.

Finish your day with a fine dining dinner and overnight on board the cruise upon arrival in Luxor.

Following your tour, take some time at leisure to wander about Luxor's bustling streets before your airport or train station transfer for departure.

### Edfu & Kom Ombo – Temples of Horus and Sobek

On arrival, your guide will take you to the Kom Ombo Temple, a unique twin temple for Sobek, god of crocodiles, and Haroeris, god of falcons. Back to the cruise for dinner and further sail to Aswan. While approaching the city, enjoy the Aswan Bridge and scenic Tombs of the Nobles under the evening sky.

### Aswan City Tour – High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple

Return to your cruise for a delicious lunch and a leisurely afternoon with tea on board. Spend your evening enjoying the serene atmosphere of Aswan.
