Day 1

Karnak Temple Complex

The magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u> Complex, one of Egypt's biggest religious sites, is where you start your Cairo cultural tour. Search through the vast expanse of this ancient temple, towering columns, walls separating the sacred lake, and other carved images and sculptures that open up a world of gods and pharaohs. Before heading to the next destination, let the taste buds enjoy lunch at a restaurant near the local area.

Luxor Temple

Before sunset, visit and enjoy this temple site, visiting the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, an architectural masterpiece dedicated to the god Amun. This great temple houses gigantic towers and vast courtyards with splendid statues. While guiding you through the temple, your guide will tell you about Luxor's essential part of worship in the ancient world and share a view of some fascinating features of the Luxor.

Day 2

West bank wonders & final departure

Valley of the Kings

First on your agenda is the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>. This area is considered the most sacred burial ground of pharaohs, as it contains some of the most renowned tombs of pharaohs of Egypt, including that of King Tutankhamun. Right after entering those tombs, your luck should allow you to behold the well-preserved colorful wall paintings and even more beautiful hieroglyphics that survived for thousands of years—here you can see the viewpoints of the ancient Egyptians regarding the afterlife.

Hatshepsut Temple

This is one of the finest architectural wonders in all of Egypt. Located on the cliffs at Deir el-Bahari, <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> honors one of Egypt's most influential female pharaohs. Steeped and surrounded by high cliffs, this temple is an absolute wonder and has always testified to the power and legacy of Hatshepsut.
