Karnak Temple

The first thing that you will be doing will be stopping at Karnak Temple, the largest religious edifice in the world. This Temple of Karnak Day Tour will enable you to look into and wonder at the fascinating histories of the temple, as your Karnak Temple Guide explains the importance of the edifice in the worship of the god Amun-Ra, and also the use in ancient Egyptian religion, while you walk under the immense Great Hypostyle Hall, comprising 134 sprawling columns. Appreciate those delightful engravings and hieroglyphics, telling stories of Egyptian deities, kings, and heroic battles, and uncover remarkable facts about Karnak through this immersive Karnak Temple Tour.

Luxor Temple

Next, your [Luxor Temple](#) Day Tour takes you to Luxor Temple, a magnificent wonder of the world that captivates visitors through its unique alignment with the banks of the Nile. Its awe-inspiring statues of Ramses II, an obelisk, and vibrant pictures of the Opet Festival (one of the most significant religious celebrations of ancient Egypt) make this temple, along with the rest built by Amenhotep III and expanded by Ramses II, priceless. Your guide will explain such interesting aspects of the construction of the temple, as well as much more about its significance as a ceremonial hub.

Valley of the Kings

Then at last get your tour guide to take you to the west bank to the Valley of the Kings, the most famed burial ground for Egypt's power shapers. Into some of the most delicately carved tombs, including the tomb of the legendary [King Tutankhamun](#), explore with a tour guide and listen to tales of kings' lives and how they prepared themselves for the afterlife. Gaze at the brilliant frescoes and hieroglyphics telling the tales of ancient mythology and eternal road travels.

Visit the Temple of Hatshepsut.

Your journey continues with a day tour of Hatshepsut Temple, a masterpiece of ancient architecture. [The Temple of Hatshepsut](#) is built into the cliffs at Deir el-Bahari. Find out about the life and reign of

Hatshepsut, Egypt's first female pharaoh, and how her legacy was immortalized in this beautiful mortuary temple. The distinct design of the temple and its divine association with the pharaoh will be explained by your guide.

Colossi of Memnon

Finally, you will visit the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two gigantic stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III, which have stood for more than 3400 years. This Colossi of Memnon Day Tour lets you uncover some great stories of history attached to these landmarks-their ancient myths and legends associated with their strange phenomenon of "singing."
