The Valley of the Kings:

Enjoy Valley of the Kings tour, <u>The Valley of the Kings</u>, called Ta-Maat by the Ancient Egyptians, was the burial place of nearly all pharaohs of the New Kingdom (1550–1080 BC).

Tombs feature descending corridors, pillared chambers, and burial chambers with stone sarcophagi. Walls display painted scenes and magical texts to aid the king in the afterlife. You will visit three recommended open tombs.

Hatshepsut Temple (El Deir El Bahary):

<u>The temple of Hatshepsut</u> at El Deir El Bahary is built on three terraces to commemorate Hatshepsut's coronation. The second terrace depicts her famous expedition to Punt.

Hatshepsut ruled Egypt around 1478 BC and died naturally. The temple, also called Al Deir El Bahary, was later used by Christians.

Colossi of Memnon:

A photo stop at the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, two 18-meter statues left from Amenhotep III's temple. The statues were said to make sounds when the wind blew at dawn.

Karnak Temples:

The largest religious complex ever built, you wil explore the temple in a extraordinary guided Karnak Temple tour which dedicated to Amon. Highlights include Sphinx Avenue, the hypostyle hall with 134 columns, obelisks of Tuthmosis I and Hatshepsut, and the sacred lake used for priest purification.

Luxor Temple:

<u>The Luxor Temple</u>, located downtown, is dedicated to goddess Mut and linked to Karnak by Sphinx Avenue. Key features include Ramses II's pylon, the colonnades, the mosque of Abu el Hagag, and the shrine of Alexander the Great.
